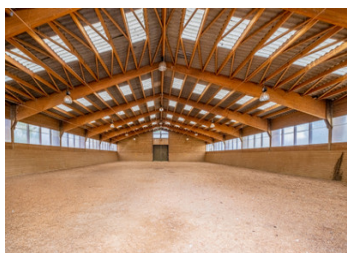

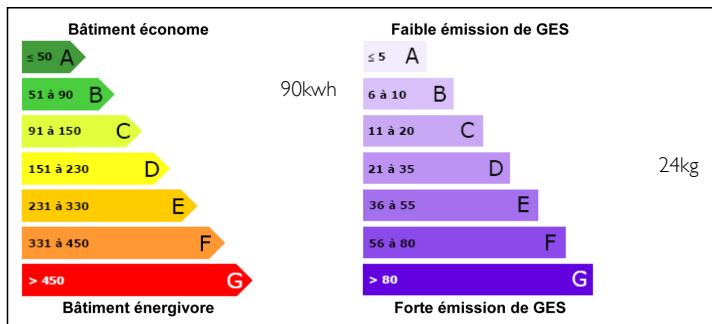

DESCRIPTION

The estate was at its most important in the 19th century as a summer residence of distinguished lords from Limoges. After a thorough renovation and a modern extension in the last 20 years, a tasteful ensemble of lovingly designed architecture was created.

Not only business rooms, workshops and a variety of equestrian / sports facilities have been added to the main building, but also a luxurious indoor swimming pool, a small chapel and well-kept park have been created. 5 minutes from the property there is a 9-hole golf course
